



## Request for Proposals (RFP) Community Mascot for Three Rivers, PEI

The Town of Three Rivers is seeking creative and meaningful ideas for a community mascot that reflects our identity, values, and spirit. This mascot will become a symbol of pride and engagement for residents and visitors alike.

**What We're Looking For:** We invite Residents of Three Rivers to submit proposals that include:

### 1. Character Concept

- Describe the mascot's appearance, personality, and any unique traits.
- Explain how the character connects to Three Rivers' heritage, culture, or natural environment.

### 2. Mascot Name

- Suggest a name that is memorable, relevant, and easy to pronounce.

### 3. Supporting Rationale

- Tell us why this character and name represent our community values and image.
- Share any stories, traditions, or local features that inspired your idea.

**Evaluation Criteria:** Council will review submissions based on:

- **Community Representation:** Does it reflect Three Rivers' identity and values?
- **Creativity:** Is the concept original and engaging?
- **Connection to Place:** Does it highlight local history, nature, or culture?
- **Ease of Use:** Is the name and design practical for future branding and events?

Council will select one winning concept. A professional mascot design will be developed based on the chosen idea. The winner will be recognized publicly and invited to participate in a mascot launch event at a time to be determined.
